



## INFORMATION ON THE USE SAFE OF POWERBANK

Always keep and follow the instructions given to ensure the safe use of the product and other connectable devices.  
Use the product and its accessories only for their intended use and in compliance with the declared electrical characteristics and in indoor/protected environments to avoid serious dangers. Keep away from heat, direct sunlight, humidity and liquids.  
Only use the cables provided with the purchased product.

The product must not be used by children or persons unable to understand any potential danger. Do not leave the product charging or connected to the mains for prolonged periods when it is not in use or if a fault is suspected.

Do not drop, crush, cut or handle the product roughly to avoid dangerous situations.

Never disassemble the product or attempt to repair it in the event of a defect.

If the product leaks fluids, avoid contact with skin or eyes; if contact occurs, immediately wash the affected area with water and consult a doctor. Do not leave packaging materials unattended, especially storage bags which are a potentially dangerous toy for children (choking, swallowing, etc.)  
Avoid using the device in proximity to electro-medical devices (e.g. pacemakers).

The product does not require maintenance and should only be cleaned with a clean and soft cloth without using aggressive agents or chemical products to avoid damage to the product."

## Commissioning

It is advisable to fully charge the Power Bank before each use.

Make sure the current values of the device correspond to the current values indicated on the Power Bank output.
